Provide a certificate of insurance. The certificate shall list the City of Longmont as additionally insured.

GENERAL NOTES

- Following the Infrastructure Permit approval, a Work in Right-of-Way Permit and traffic control plan will be required prior to start of work. Work start date, duration, contacts and payment will then be completed.
- All work within the public right-of-way or easement shall conform to the City of Longmont Construction Specifications and Design Standards.
- The Contractor shall provide all traffic control necessary to provide for public safety in accordance with the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
