You will receive notification of the City rebates you qualify for based on your information. These rebates will be applied as a credit on your utility bill or as a check to your home address if you do not receive a utility bill. Processing time can be up to six weeks. Receiving a rebate from the City of Longmont does not affect any other current assistance.
