



LOOMILLER PARK RENEWAL INTERIM PLAN DRAFT 4-10-2019

Loomiller Pond
Loomiller Pond will not be managed as a fishery and the surface will be allowed to freeze in the winter. This will result in some initial fish die-off, however, it will reduce the goose population at the park and ultimately improve water quality. Aeration of the pond will be optional based on oxygenation and odor control needs. Fishing will not be prohibited, but the pond will not be stocked.

Irrigation
Loomiller Park is currently irrigated with potable water. Conversion to utilization of raw water for irrigation will be considered if it's determined to be an overall benefit to the City.

Disc Golf
The existing disc golf course will remain at Loomiller Park until such time that a new disc golf course of equal caliber is provided at another public site, such as a City Community Park. Until that time, the disc golf course may need to be altered slightly to accommodate some of the immediate upgrades to the park. Alterations are shown conceptually on the plan, however, disc golfers will be consulted for final relocations.

Art
Community art installations are desired at Loomiller Park and should be incorporated with improvements to the park whenever feasible.

Lighting
Park lighting will be evaluated for efficiency and upgraded to LED.
