- Completed Tastings Schedule
- Written plan describing how the tastings event will be controlled and conducted in accordance with State statutes and the City of Longmont Municipal Code (for example identification verification, monitoring number of consumed samples by patrons, how unconsumed alcohol will be destroyed or removed from the premises, etc.)
- List of individuals who will conduct tastings events and proof of completion of a server training program approved by the State Liquor Enforcement Division for each

Applicants are expected to understand and abide by these regulations as set forth in C.R.S. 44-3-301(10)(a) through (f):

- Tastings shall not exceed a total of five (5) hours in duration per day, which need not be consecutive
- Tastings shall be conducted only on the licensed premises
- Tastings shall take place in no case earlier than 11:00 a.m. or later than 9:00 p.m.
- The licensee may conduct tastings no more than one hundred fifty-six (156) days per year.
- The licensee shall not serve more than four (4) individual samples to a patron during a tasting event
- Alcohol samples shall be in open containers and shall be provided to a patron free of charge
- The size of an individual sample shall not exceed one ounce (1 oz.) of malt or vinous liquor or one-half ounce (1/2 oz.) of spirituous liquor
- The licensee shall prohibit patrons from leaving the licensed premises with an unconsumed sample
- The licensee shall promptly remove all open and unconsumed alcohol beverage samples from the licensed premises, destroy the samples immediately following the completion of the tasting, or store any open containers of unconsumed alcohol beverages in a secure area outside the sales area of the licensed premises for use at a tasting conducted at a later time or date.
- The licensee shall not serve a person who is under twenty-one years of age or who is visibly intoxicated

Oath of Applicant:

I hereby certify that the information in this application and all attachments is true, correct, and complete to the best of my knowledge; that it is my responsibility to assure that all employees conducting the Tastings events be certified in a State approved Responsible Vendor Training; that my liquor license is valid and not subject to a current or pending enforcement action by the City of Longmont or the State of Colorado and is in full force and effect; that it is my responsibility and the responsibility of my agents and employees to comply with all applicable local and State laws, rules, and regulations as they relate to the serving, selling and distribution of alcohol beverages; and that any violation of a limitation specified in local and State laws, rules, and regulations by a retail liquor store or liquor-licensed drugstore licensee, whether by his or her employees, agents, or otherwise, shall be the responsibility of the retail liquor store or liquor-licensed drugstore licensee who is conducting the tasting.
