An **asbestos test** has been obtained and submitted, as well as the clearance report, if asbestos was present.

Each of the **utility providers has been scheduled to disconnect service** before the final permit is issued. All utilities shall be disconnected a minimum of 24 hours prior to the demolition of the structure.

Public Works and Natural Resources - Water / Sewer

All accounts must be current, with no back fees.

Applicant must provide a written request from the building owner authorizing meter removal.

Applicant must call (303) 651-8416 to schedule the removal of the water meter at least 24 hours before the demolition.

Century Link or Comcast/Xfinity

CenturyLink has been contacted at (877) 803-8414 to schedule service disconnection between 8 am and 6 pm, Monday through Friday.

Xfinity has been contacted at 1-800-XFINITY or (800) 266-2278 to schedule service disconnection between 9 am and 7 pm.

Longmont Fire Department

Please have available the type of building, whether the building is asbestos-free, and what the Fire Dept. is allowed to do.

Xcel Energy

Xcel Energy has been contacted to schedule a service disconnection and they have removed the gas meter.
